Dear Parent/Carer

New School Meal Price from 1st September 2016 - For Nursery & Junior Children

I write to inform you that from 1st September 2016 there will be a 10p price increase in the cost of a school meal for paying pupils in Nursery & Juniors, from £1.90 to £2.00 per day. This is the first price increase since 2014 and it is important to note that school meals in Salford remain very competitive compared to other authorities in the North West.

Our new menus now include British chicken, beef, turkey and fish from a sustainable source, free range eggs and locally produced fresh vegetables, and meet the new government food based guidelines. All the food used in menus at Marlborough Road Academy is halal and our menus always include a vegetarian option.

Citywide Catering Service, as always, remains committed to providing a quality service and healthy meal to your child at lunchtime and we will continue to work in close partnership with your school to ensure we achieve this.

If your child is in Nursery, Year 3, 4, 5 or 6 and you pay for school meals, you should send £10.00 to the school each Friday for the following week as meals can only be ordered once payment is made.

If you feel you may be entitled to free school meals, you can arrange this by contacting the school office for further details.
