History

To explore changes within living memory. I can talk about who I am, where I come from and what makes me, me?

Art/Design

Develop the skills needed for drawing and painting. Investigate and experiment with lines, shapes and colours to sketch and paint portraits of themselves.

Key Question: Who am I?

<u>Music</u>

The children will be learning about pulse, rhythm and pitch through the song 'Hey You'.

PE/Dance/Gymnastic

To be physically active and develop the skills of balancing and moving. Compete against themselves to improve their skills of agility, balance and coordination.

Computing

Use technology purposefully to create, organise, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

R.E: Christianity

Key question: Does God want Christians to look after the world?

Geography

To name and locate the world's seven continents by exploring the country my family is from and the country we live in now.

Science

Who am I?

Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

English

This half term the children will be reading the book 'Where's my Teddy?'.

They will be learning to read new words correctly by blending the letter and letter group sounds they have been taught. They will begin to use their phonics skills to write simple sentences for stories.

The children will also be following the Nelson Handwriting scheme 3 times a week.

<u>Maths</u>

This half term the children will be exploring and working with numbers to 10, adding and subtracting within 10 and learning about shapes and patterns.

They will be using the scheme Maths Mastery which enables them to develop a wide use of vocabulary and reasoning skills.
