This is what we are learning in Year 2

History

We will be looking closely at photos of Salford 100 years ago and comparing them to Salford now. We will also be talking about similarities and differences between them.

Children will research the life of children 100 years ago and make comparisons to children of today. They will also research L S Lowry and complete a fact sheet following our reading to writing journey.

Art/Design

Children will learn about perspective from artists on our Lowry visit. They will develop their sketching skills.

Computing

The focus will be presentation skills. The children will become familiar with power point and will be able to launch the program, to research facts about Lowry and to be able to find and insert a Lowry painting onto a slide.

Key Question: What was Salford like 100 years ago?
Key question: Why was Lowry a significant figure for Salford?

Music

We will develop our singing ability through songs linked to Lowry and Salford.

PE/Dance/Gymnastic

WE will improve our agility, balance, stamina and coordination in athletics - running, jumping and throwing through boot camp style training.

R.E: / PHSE

WE will focus on resilience and look at who and what can help us. We will be discussing feelings, friends and knowing what we are good at.

Science

We will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food, air). Children will be able to describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amount of different types of food and hygiene.

English

Our objectives are:

Reading

- To code words using phonic skills and re-read texts to develop fluency.
- To understand the meanings of words and link them to words already known.
- To find information in the text to answer questions.
- To make simple inferences about characters' actions and feelings.
- To understand the sequence of events in books.

Writing

- To use capital letters, spaces and full stops in sentences.
- To begin to use expanded noun phrases.
- To spell some words correctly and use phonics to sound out others.
- To understand and use nouns, verbs and adjectives correctly in their writing.
- To begin to use some conjunctions in their writing.
- To make sure that their writing makes sense.
- To form letters correctly and of the correct size.

Maths

- To partition 2 digit numbers in different ways.
- To use place value and number facts to solve problems.
- To identify, represent, compare and order numbers to 100.
- To add and subtract using bonds to 20.
- To add and subtract ones and tens to and from 2 digit numbers.
- To add and subtract two 2 digit numbers.
- To solve problems using concrete and pictorial representations to develop mental and written methods.
- To recognise inverse relationships of operations.
